We are trying something completely new this year,
... a Radiothon!

We are partnering with Radio Station K102.5, Kalamazoo's Greatest Hits, to host a Radiothon on Saturday, July 27, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Wings of God will be highlighted on the radio for two weeks, inviting listeners to visit our web site and donate. The promotion ends with a nine-hour telethon, during which listeners can call into Wings of God and give.

A Bucket Brigade will be happening at the same time all over downtown Paw Paw! "Bucketeers" will be standing in neon pink shirts collecting donations from people passing by willing to place money in the bucket. We also will be placing buckets in various business locations as well as standing at entrance doors to collect.
