# PRAISING GOD IN 2020

Peace at Wings of God prevailed in 2020. In the midst of the changes and challenges of the pandemic and lockdowns, we relied on God, sought His wisdom, and He gave us His peace that surpasses all understanding.

From the beginning of the pandemic, our staff prayed for God’s guidance to continue providing consistent and meaningful programming to the women in a safe living environment. We crafted a comprehensive Covid plan that covered both Pearls and staff. Our volunteer mentors, leaders, and counselors switched to Zoom meetings and socially distanced porch gatherings. Everything proceeded smoothly, and it was powerful to witness everyone’s resilience and commitment to keep loving one another. God is unstoppable!

Jesus said, “Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.” Leaning on this promise was essential in 2020. Two Pearls grieved the death of their fathers. Praise God he sent willing Christians to offer grief counseling. Two women overcame doubts of their role as mothers and have found renewed communication and healing with their children. Several women have committed to staying sober. Three women could not, and yet we know if they seek God, they will find him, he is not far from any one of us. (Acts 17:27).



An obstacle for 2020 was our inability to make in-person jail presentations to women because of lockdown restrictions. Personal visits to women in area jails is our opportunity to answer questions and pray with women who are interested in trying a new path – a path of restoration and healing in Jesus. To adjust to this hurdle, we updated our website with more information for potential program participants, and we implemented a plan to have continuous communications with people and agencies who serve with individuals who may be a potential good fit for our program. We are also getting Wings of God flyers into the hands of inmates in area jails.

The challenges of 2020 have only strengthened our commitment going into 2021 to women who desperately need the peace that comes from a relationship with Jesus. We are committed to sharing the gospel every day, to helping put families back together, and being God’s beacon of light to the Pearls, staff, volunteers, and the world. We rejoice in God’s provision financially and with a great team and abundant community support.

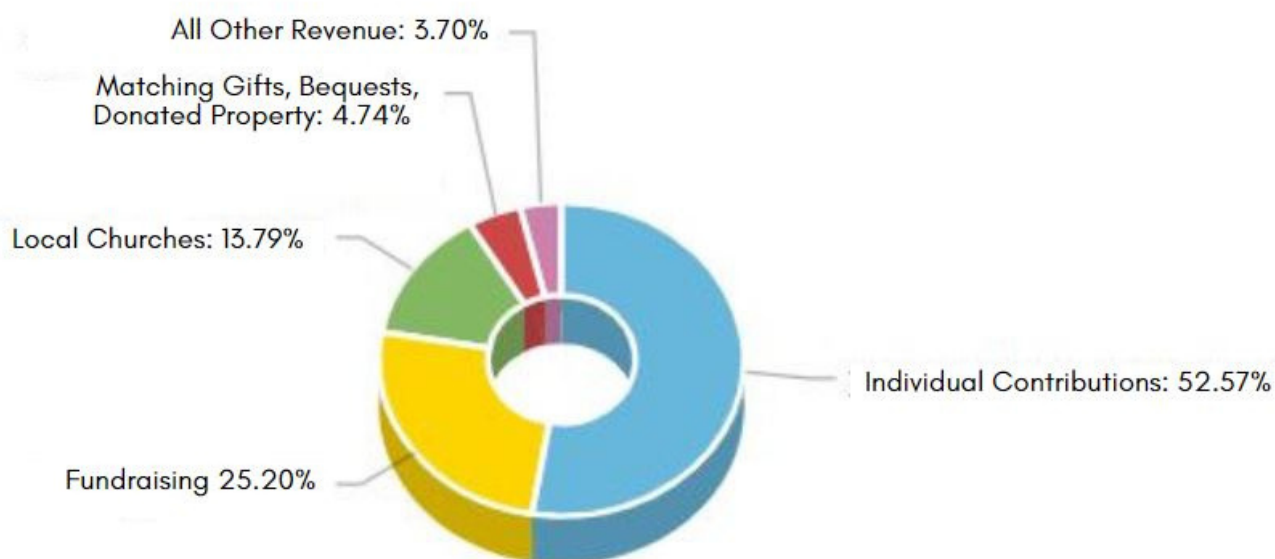
