Meeting the incredible need for affordable housing in our community for women with a jail background, Wings of God has purchased a duplex in downtown Paw Paw, MI. The home will be used exclusively for Pearls who have minor children or have regular visitation with their minor children. This home was **PAID IN FULL** and is **DEBT-FREE** thanks to a generous donor. Repairs and improvements are underway and will soon be open to housing our first Pearl in late Spring 2022.

WINGS OF GOD LEGACY HOUSE

After years of community need and much prayer, men will now have a place of healing similar to the Wings of God women's house. Wings of God is leasing a home in Paw Paw to provide a welcoming home for men.

The mission of the Legacy House is to equip men to break free from the stronghold of addiction within the safety of a Christ-centered home as they strive to pursue a life giving, hope-filled, legacy rooted in Jesus Christ.

The Legacy House will be a home for men who desire knowing the TRUTH and to be SET FREE from the affects of poor life choices. It will accommodate seven men, sharing the common areas of the home and shared bedrooms. Each participant will pay a program fee while working full-time and participating in the program. The home is anticipating opening in July, 2022.

Volunteer Opportunities

Studying a variety of books is part of the programming at Wings of God. Across four semesters, 16 books are taught in a group setting. The books chosen for this curriculum are a part of our mission to equip women to successfully change their lives. Study guides are provided for each book. Four teachers are needed for the first Fall semester starting on August 29, 2022 for eight weeks, once a week, ending October 21, 2022. We also need four teachers for the second eight-week Fall semester October 24 — December 16, 2022.
