Pearl Spotlight Setback not a failure, but an opportunity for second chance

I am a previous Pearl and a graduate of the Wings of God program. After graduating from the program, I went to live at the new Second Step Home. I relapsed nine months later. The staff at Wings of God asked me to leave. After leaving the Second Step Home, I was homeless during my year-long relapse. I lost my job, my savings, and my self-worth. It took God humbling me and losing everything for me to see that I couldn't do it on my own, that I needed God and His will in my life, not my own.

I also got into some legal trouble. I was sentenced to drug treatment court again and probation. I knew that I wouldn't be able to do drug court without residing somewhere within walking distance of the courthouse and I wouldn't be able to get the reset I needed

without Wings of God. I swallowed my pride and asked to come back. I knew I would get the love, care, and structure I needed to get clean. When I came back, I wasn't judged or looked at differently. I was greeted with God's love, safety, and tender guidance.

I once again have my daughter back in my life. I also have a job and have had no probation or drug court violations. The most important thing I have gained back, though, is a deeper relationship with God.


