HOUSE MANAGERS REPORT

In 2025, the Pearls enjoyed a full and meaningful year overflowing with connection, growth, and community engagement. We welcomed seven new participants, celebrated ten birthdays, honored two graduates, and continued sharing hope through monthly Witness the Hope Tours. The women took part in a wide range of life-giving activities—everything from serving meals to local organizations and attending concerts, to special outings like horseback riding, the Tulip Festival, Binder Park Zoo, and the Berrien County Youth Fair. They hosted and joined multiple ministry events, participated in church conferences, volunteered in the community, and gathered with former Pearls for meals and celebrations throughout the year. Holidays were marked with heartfelt traditions, including Thanksgiving, Christmas festivities, and caroling. This year also brought meaningful milestones, such as two Pearls moving into our Next Step Homes (now expanded to three apartments), GED completion, and joyful graduation celebrations. It was a year filled with encouragement, new experiences, and Christ-centered fellowship that nurtured healing and hope for each woman.



Classes remain at the heart of daily life in the home, providing structure, spiritual growth, emotional healing, and practical tools for long-term success. Taught by dedicated volunteer instructors, these courses guide the Pearls through Scripture-based studies, personal development, and recovery work. Over the year, they explored topics such as identity in Christ, healthy relationships, discipleship, moral decision-making, emotional wellness, boundaries, and healing from past wounds. Studies like **Uninvited**, **Purpose Driven Life**, **Healing the Wounded Heart**, **Boundaries**, and **Moral Recognition Therapy** offered deep insight and space for transformation. Together, these classes create a safe learning environment where the Pearls can grow in faith, strengthen life skills, understand God's purpose for their lives, and build a solid foundation for their future.
